



SCHOOL TOURS of PORT SAINT JOHN 2020-21

Port Saint John is proud to partner with Anglophone South School District and PALS to offer tours to schools throughout the district from **September to May**.

- **Tours take place on Fridays from 9:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. One tour per date.**
- **This tour is ideally suited to students Grade 5 and up.**
- **For younger students, a more general tour can be offered.**
- **For older students, tours can be specialized to highlight job opportunities in Port-related industries.**

Port tours provide an opportunity for students to experience the Port – up close and personal! They will see how the Port works, what the Port does and how it connects to our community. They are encouraged to ask questions and engage with their tour guide to help them learn even more!

This fun, interactive and educational experience takes students to the:

- **Barrack Point Potash Terminal** potash and salt handling facility (information about potash, rail systems, salt production, etc.)
- **Rodney Container Terminal** (how New Brunswick connects to the world, how shipping works, what products come from New Brunswick)
- **American Iron and Metal** (the importance of recycling, demand for recycled metal, trucking systems)
- **Atlantic Towing Tug Boats** (how tugboats work, why they matter in our harbour, etc.)

Before planning your visit, here are some things to keep in mind.

- This tour is not recommended for students below the age of 10.
- You are required to provide your own transportation to the port, and your bus must remain with you as you do the tour.
- Tours are designed for one regular-sized class – larger groups do not get as much out of the tour. Thank you.
- For reasons of safety and security, the tour is conducted entirely aboard the bus. At no point will students be disembarking.
- Please take care to arrive on time. The tour departs at approximately 9:30 a.m. from the Marco Polo Cruise Terminal (111 Water St.) Instruct your driver to pull through the gates between the terminals and park in a safe location. If your guide is not waiting for you, feel free to call 639-5807. (During cruise season you may be directed to an alternate start point.)
- The duration of the tour is approximately 1.5 hours.
- There are no bathroom breaks available during the tour.
- Please submit the names of all participants over the age of 16 on your registration page. (including teachers/chaperones). If there are any last-minute additions, please give your name to your guide before beginning the tour.
